

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

The annual election of the members of the Board of Education is held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in general election years. Board members are elected on a nonpartisan ballot in accordance with the provisions of the Wyoming Election Code.

School District Number one has seven board members. Five members are elected from the Rock Springs, Superior, Reliance area; one board member from the Farson/Eden (former District #21) area; and one from the Wamsutter (former District #1) area. All board members are elected by the electors of the entire district.

All board members--are elected for a term of four years which begins at 12:00 noon on the first day of December following the election. The terms are staggered for Board continuity.
