

RELATIONS WITH RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS
Release Time for Off-Campus Religious Classes

The Board will cooperate with the various religious organizations in the communities by permitting students to attend off-campus religious classes.

The following regulations shall govern the release time program:

1. The school will grant release time to students in grades 10 through 12.
2. The school will decide during what periods release time will be allowed.
3. Religious organizations that wish to take advantage of the release time program must contact the high school principal for arrangements. The school may set up a system of registration for attending religious classes, but no advertising or recruiting shall be done by the school.
4. No credit will be given by the school for religious classes attended nor will any grades appear on the students' transcripts.
5. All religious classes must be held off school premises. The religious organizations will be responsible for providing facilities, equipment, staff and any other costs associated with their programs.
6. The school will provide lists of students who sign up for release time to the religious organizations who request them.
