

FOREIGN STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Foreign students participating in a recognized exchange program may be accepted into a host school in Sweetwater County School District Number One for either one or two semesters. Students will be enrolled in the school through a foreign exchange program given the following:

1. Foreign student exchange program must be a non-profit organization.
2. Foreign student exchange program must have a local representative in the area to deal with issues such as, but not limited to, housing, school enrollment, medical issues, travel and problems that may arise during student's stay in the United States.
3. Foreign student exchange program must handle all issues concerning United States Immigration and Naturalization laws.
4. Host school must designate an administrator to oversee the placement of student in school and work as a liaison between school and exchange program.

Based on the recommendations from the Council on Standards for International Education and Travel, there is to be 1 foreign exchange student per 300 students in host school. Foreign students will be enrolled on a "first-come, first-serve" basis in host school, based on organizational paperwork and enrollment deadlines.
