

CLASS SIZE

In following Wyoming State Statute W.S. 21-13-307 (a) (iv) School District Number One will, make every attempt to, keep class loads working toward the student-teacher ratio requirement of sixteen (16) to one (1) with 23 maximum students from kindergarten through third grade; and 27 maximum students in fourth through twelfth grades with the class average determined by the Superintendent/designee including music, art, library, and physical education classes. Class size adjustments in accordance with these limits will be made by the school board meeting in September. In the event that a placement should put a class load in excess of the maximum limits, such placement should require board approval. Board approval for a class load in excess of the maximum limits shall not be required for secondary instrumental and vocal music classes and outlying area schools' physical education and performing arts classes.
