

SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The Board generally meets in regular session on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. The Board shall annually in July give notice of the regular meetings of the Board and the availability of the minutes of these meetings. Such notice shall be published in a newspaper circulating in the district.

Special meetings may be called at any time by the Board chairman upon the request of the superintendent or any member of the Board, with the approval of the chairman. The public shall be informed through the news media at least 48 hours in advance of the time, place, and purpose of such meeting. Action shall be limited to items related to the purpose or purposes for which the meeting was called.

The Board chairman may call an emergency meeting to take temporary action on a matter of serious immediate concern without notice. If possible, reasonable effort shall be made to notify the public. All action taken at such a meeting shall be reconsidered and acted upon permanently at an open public meeting within 48 hours of the emergency meeting.

All meetings of the Board are open to the public and press except for executive or closed sessions which are defined by law as meetings limited to the members of the Board and such other persons as are specifically invited to attend (see BDC, Executive Sessions).
